


Who's the Guide for?

The Housing First Model

- Effective way to end homelessness
 - High needs
 - Intensive support
 - Immediate access to housing

Broader services and shift

- Encourage traditional homeless services to follow this approach
- Focus on user choice, rather than conditionality based approaches

Unit 2. Core Principles of Housing First



- 1. Housing is a human right
- 2. Choice and control for service users
- 3. Separation of housing and treatment
- 4. Recovery orientation
- 5. Harm reduction
- 6. Active engagement without coercion
- 7. Person-centred planning
- 8. Flexible support for as long as is required



European Union - Social Rights

- Recent development = possibly opportunity to include Housing First in EU policy - Social Rights Pillar
- Article 34 of the Charter of Fundamental Rights
- 19.Housing
 - Access to social housing or housing assistance.
 - Shelter shall be provided to those that are homeless, and shall be linked up to other social services in order to promote social integration.



Housing First Europe Hub

- Co-funded by Y-Foundation in Finland
- Partner organisations and foundations from:
 - UK, Norway, The Netherlands, Italy, Spain, Sweden and France, etc.
- Focus on Practice and Training, Research and Policy
