KLIMAKA identity

- KLIMAKA is a registered N.G.O. working to combat the several dimensions of social exclusion.
- Our services concern the following groups of potential users:
- People with mental disorders
- Culturally differentiated populations (ROM, Muslims)
- Homeless
- Women victims of trafficking
- Humanitarian aid in developmental countries (Iraq, Afghanistan)
- Other vulnerable groups
- Designs strategic procedures and policies for social inclusion
- Introduces to the national government ideas about the social inclusion
- Offers seminars for health professionals (for example an educational programme/seminar for street working)

OUR WORK WITH THE HOMELESS

- Regarding the phenomenon of homelessness, we have developed the following services:
- Street working unit
- First aid medical health care – emergent medical assistance
- Psychiatric assessment, counseling, social services and medication
- Day center for the homeless
- Hostel (temporary accommodation) for 12 persons
- Establishing the documentation system (creation of a database, research activities)
- Educational seminars for homeless people about health issues

THE BENEFIT OF A SOCIAL COOPERATION

- Work for homeless people with mental health problems
- People with mental health problems can work there without losing their disability social benefits
- Socialization for people with mental health problems
- Economic independence for people with mental health problems
- The working rehabilitation of people with mental health issues has as a direct result the battle against racism and prejudice

SOCIAL COOPERATION

- Mental health unit and social enterprise
- The working rehabilitation of people with mental health issues has as a direct result the battle against racism and prejudice
- A main part of KLIMAKA'S social corporation is funded by the Ministry of Health

PROFILE OF THE SOCIAL COOPERATION OF KLIMAKA

- A lorry
- A driver
- 10 homeless, who live in KLIMAKA's hostel
- Average of 50 tons paper per month
- Collaboration with 162 companies
- The income is 3.500 euro per month and covers the operational expenses the rest of the profit goes to the workers.

KLIMAKAS' wider action

- Develops actions of social economy
- Supported by a vast network of sponsors
- A privet mini bus which transports people who can not move by themselves.
