What is the FEAD Plus?

FEAD Plus = Fund of the European Aid for the Most Deprived

- Belongs to the ESF Plus
- Fund to fight against poverty in Europe
- German: EHAP →

Integration helps counter the exclusion of the most deprived

Target groups

1. Particularly deprived newly arrived EU citizens and their children under the age of 18
2. Homeless people or people at risk of homelessness and their children under the age of 18





What are the goals?

Society

- Raise public awareness on antigypsism and anti-discrimination
- Orientation to the horizontal principles gender equality, non-discrimination and the ecological dimension of sustainability

Target group

- Improvement of living conditions
- Empowerment
- Fostering of social inclusion
- Facilitating access to existing structures and strengthening their impact



What are the measures?

- Financing of low-threshold counselling services that flank the existing system
- Funding of staff positions for training on the topics of antigypsism and anti-discrimination
- Complementary nationwide low-threshold pilot project for outreach information and referral counselling on social media

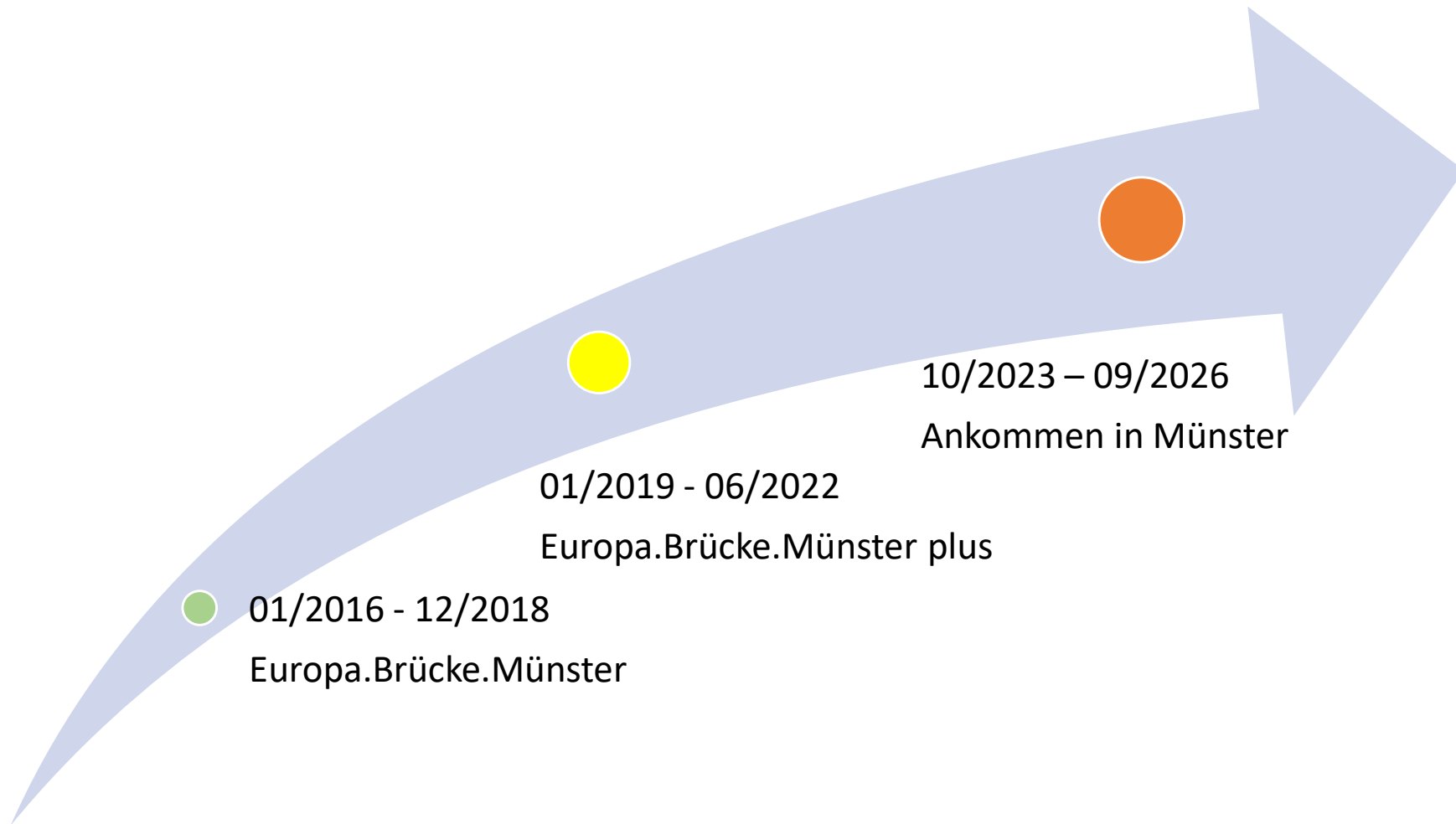

Project Ankommen in Münster (AIM_EU)

➔ Focus on target group 1

- Main problems
 - Absolute Poverty
 - Social exclusion, multi-factorial discrimination
 - Unemployment
 - (Unlawful) exclusion from social welfare benefits
 - Homelessness (around 80 %)
 - Missing Health Care Insurance

- Organisation and participation in the annual Weeks against Racism

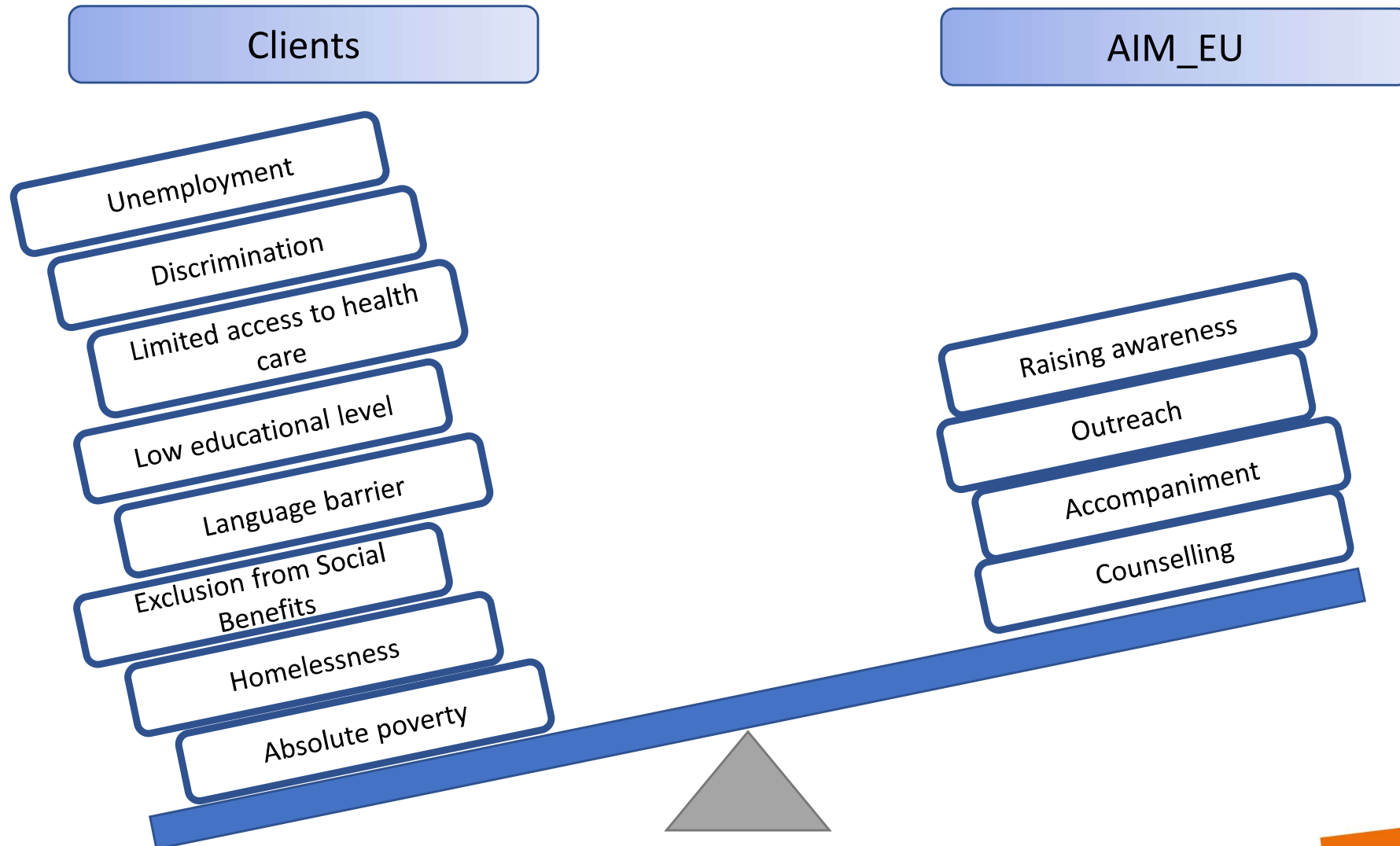
Network

Cooperation with Stadt Münster

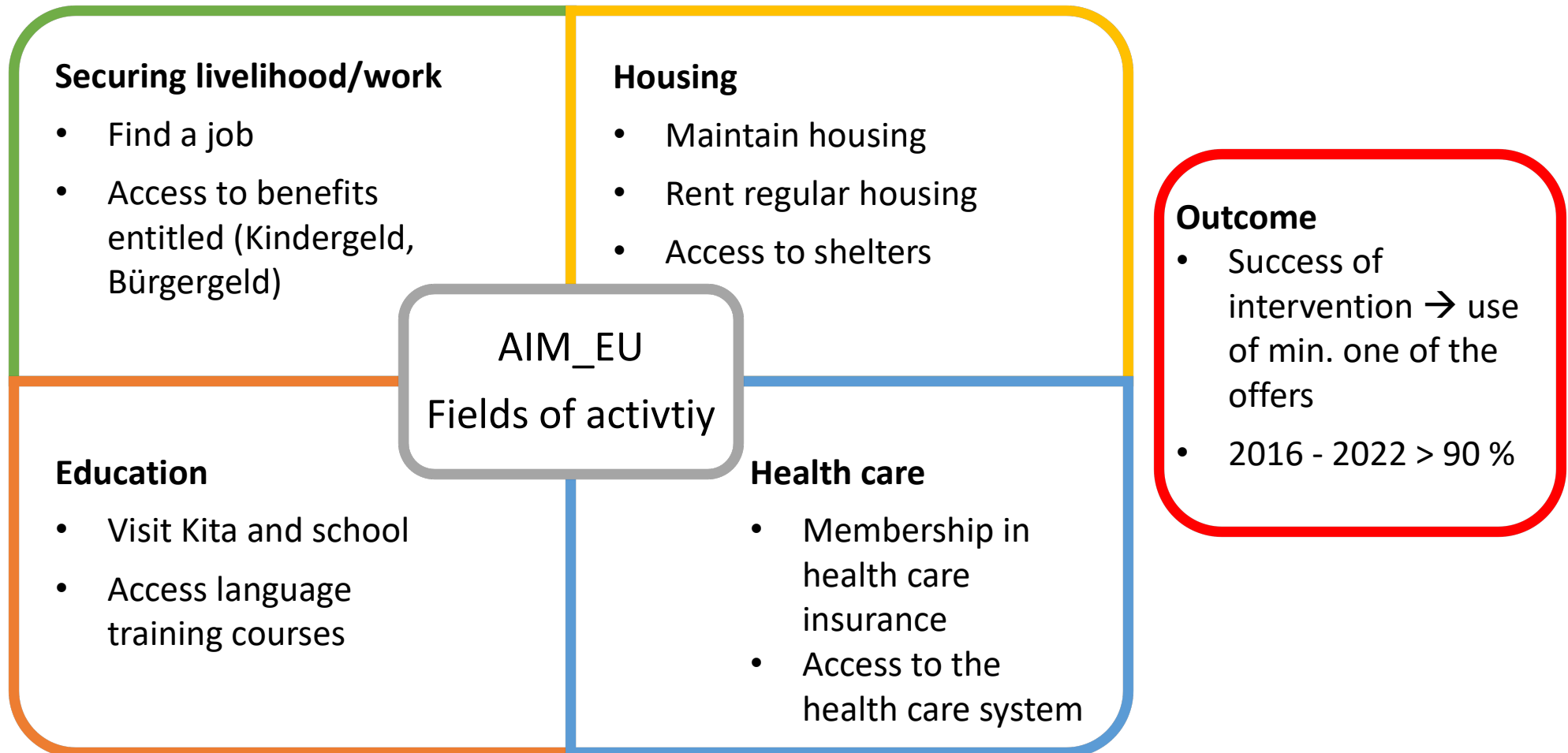


The scale is out of balance
