Background

- Y-Foundation
 - is a non-profit housing provider
 - one of the key actors on developing & implementing HF in Finland and on work against homelessness
 - over 17,000 apartments
 - over 10,000 for "normal" social housing M2
 - around 5,500 for special groups
 - almost 1,100 directly leased by the Y–Foundation
 - the rest are subleased to municipalities and NGOs



• It is in our strategy to increase the social and economic welfare of our residents

Therefore, we want to know:

- How do our residents define their own welfare, health and financial situation?
 - Emphasis on the subjective welfare (not only on the measurable resources to be used)



Sample and methods

Sample & methods

- Ongoing research, started in December 2018
- People who have moved in to Y-Foundation flats since the end of last year
- Information letter when signing the contract
- Residents are contacted by phone after they have "settled in"
- n=45
 - Out of 122 who have moved in between December and the end of July 2019
 - 57 will not participate (refusals, number no longer in use, no reply, do not turn up for an interview, contract has finished)
 - 20 are pending (interview agreed or will be contacted again)



Sample and methods

- Structured interview
- Many questions have been used previously
- Possibility to be contacted later on about work opportunities and finance advice
- Participation voluntary
- Consent form
- Two cinema tickets
- Option for a follow up after a year



Preliminary results


Who

- Gender: 36 % female ; 64 % male
- Nationality: 96 % Finnish; Native language: 96 % Finnish
- Age: 18-69 (41)
- Current status:
 - Other: 32 %
 - Pensioner: 27 %
 - Working full-time: 16 %
 - Student 11%
- Education:
 - Comprehensive school: 47 %
 - Vocational school: 27 %
- Previous accommodation
 - Supported housing: 46 %
 - Rental accommodation 30 %
 - Living with parents 11 %
- Number of people in the household: 1-2 (86 % single person households)
- Under aged children only in 5 households, children over 18 in three households

If you think about your life at the moment, how satisfied are you with the following aspects (on a scale of 0-10)?






Everyday life – things that ...

■ Fully agree ■ partly agree ■ neither agree nor disagree ■ partly disagree ■ fully disagree



Received benefits within last two months






Use of services
